- The further freight contract liability agreed with the principals within the framework of the provided legal liability corridor according to § 449 Para. 2 No. 1 HGB to up to 40 special drawing rights (SDR) per kg of the gross weight of the consignment;
- Convention on the Contract for the International Carriage of Goods by Road (CMR);
- Budapest Convention on the Contract for the Carriage of Goods by Inland Waterway (CMNI);
- Convention concerning International Carriage by Rail and Uniform Rules concerning the Contract for International Carriage of Goods by Rail (Appendix B - COTIF/CIM, current version);

WACS clause module

Cover for liability arising from the carriage of swap bodies, trailers, containers and semi-trailers, etc. The insurance benefit is limited to the loss in value (current market value) of the transport container, up to a maximum of EUR 100.000 per loss event.

Heavy cargo module

Coverage for liability arising from heavy lift contracts.

The insurance benefit is limited to EUR 2.500.000 per claim and EUR 5.000.000 per loss event.

Customs and excise duties module

Cover for liability arising from the execution of customs clearances of any kind (customs orders).

The insurance benefit is limited to EUR 75.000 per customs offence and EUR 750.000 per insurance year.

Based on this confirmation, the insurer(s) shall not assume any obligation towards third parties. In particular, this confirmation does not oblige the insurer(s) or OSKAR SCHUNCK GmbH to inform about changes or terminations of the insurance cover.
